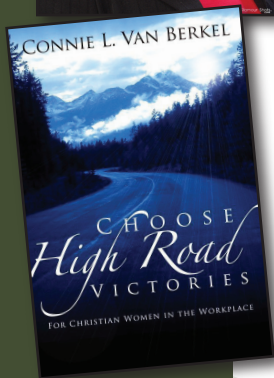


CONNIE VAN BERKEL
